Career And Technical Education/Vocational Scholarships 2024

Scholarships of \$1,000.00 are available, open to qualifying graduates from the following high schools (Turlock, Pitman, Denair, Hilmar, Hughson, Roselawn, Irwin, Keyes Charter, and Turlock Christian). Students who will be entering career and technical education programs (CTE) at community colleges, technical training institutions, or vocational training programs may apply for financial scholarship awards. This award may be applied to costs associated with tuition, books, tools, and supplies that are associated with specific CTE programs.
