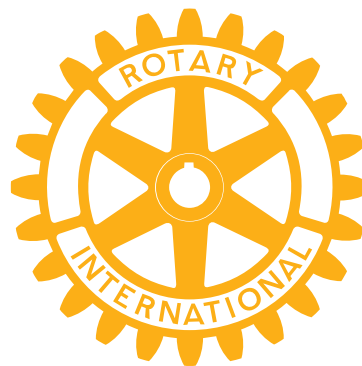

Our Program This Week was Jessica Vaughan - Second Harvest of the Greater Valley

Second Harvest is a food bank located in Manteca. It is part of a larger network that serves multiple counties in the Central Valley, Stanislaus, San Joaquin, and others. They distribute millions of pounds of food annually to food pantries, shelters, and meal programs, to ensure that food reaches vulnerable populations.



Food collection drive dates are set for 10/28 to 11/15 with distribution on 11/19

We have a collection box in the Wilkey building, or you can make a donation, and we will purchase food again this year. Food will be donated to New Life Christian Center Food Bank



" When donating to a food bank, it's important to choose non-perishable, nutritious items that have a long shelf life. Canned vegetables & fruits, canned proteins: tuna, chicken, beans, peanut butter. Grain and carbohydrates: instant rice, pasta, noodles, potatoes, oatmeal. Canned or boxed meals: soups, stews, chili, pasta kits. Shelf stable milk: powdered milk, dairy, almond or soy. Snacks: granola bars, dried fruit, crackers. Cooking essentials: salt, pepper, basic spices in small packets. Toiletries: toothpaste, shampoo, soap, (travel size), Diapers, baby wipes, feminine hygiene products. Donation Tips: avoid items in glass containers, check expiration dates, remember some of your donations go to children who cook for the family. Some families have no way to cook other than a microwave or camp stove."



The Club is going to help serve meals during the holidays.

Tina Ging is working with the Gospel Mission to get a date for a Thanksgiving meal serving opportunity. This will be a family event, more information as we get closer to the date.
