"When donating to a food bank, it's important to choose non-perishable, nutritious items that have a long shelf life. Canned vegetables & fruits, canned proteins: tuna, chicken, beans, peanut butter. Grain and carbohydrates: instant rice, pasta, noodles, potatoes, oatmeal. Canned or boxed meals: soups, stews, chili, pasta kits. Shelf stable milk: powdered milk, dairy, almond or soy. Snacks: granola bars, dried fruit, crackers. Cooking essentials: salt, pepper, basic spices in small packets. Toiletries: toothpaste, shampoo, soap, (travel size), Diapers, baby wipes, feminine hygiene products. Donation Tips: avoid items in glass containers, check expiration dates, remember some of your donations go to children who cook for the family. Some families have no way to cook other than a microwave or camp stove."
